Here's some activities for you to do this week:

Monday:

Foundation Phase/KS2 – Picasso was a very famous artist, one very important to the style of abstraction and cubism! Have a look at the work he has done and try to copy your favourite!

Tuesday:

Foundation Phase/KS2 – Picasso loved to add instruments to his work, what is your favourite instrument? Can you sketch/paint it in his style?

Wednesday:

Foundation Phase/KS2 – Picasso was very famous for his paintings of faces. Faces that were very abstract. Follow the video to see how to draw a face just like him!
