



Attendance

We are looking forward to welcoming all children back to school in September!

Key Information:

- All children are expected to attend school unless they have a Shielding Letter from the Chief Medical Officer.
- If a child lives in a household with someone who has a Shielding Letter, they should only attend school where they are strictly able to adhere to social distancing measures and understand these. This may not be possible for younger learners.
- Regular handwashing and sanitising will be part of the school day.
- Children will remain in their class groups and contact between classes will be at a minimum.
- Parents should contact school in the usual way if their child is unwell and cannot attend.

To ease congestion and ensure social distancing measures can be followed we have staggered the drop-off and collection times for different classes.

The "New" School Day
