Let's Get Moving

Can you play a game of chase? Brothers and sisters especially like to be chased. Don't forget the cues: 1,2,3 or READY, STEADY, GO! How many pieces of equipment can you play chase on or in? Chair, wheelchair, walker, standing frame or acheevaetc



-Use your arms and/legs to knock down things like Naughty Henry did in the story.
-You could even try using a cloth to pull stacked toys/unbreakable dishes and pans down with support too. Did it make a big crash? And did you make a BIG mess?



Getting Creative

Make a special bed or house for Henry to feel safe, cosy and warm inside.

It can be small or big enough for you to try out too!

Help your child to choose the fabrics/materials/colours they want to choose.



Let's Get Messy

Henry knocked the flowers over!
Can you recreate the mess made using flowers and compost on a tray?
Use your hands to explore.



Let's Discover

Gran had so much cleaning to do with Naughty Henry!

Can you find different cloths, sponges and brushes to explore.

Try using them in soapy water too. With help can you use your hands squeeze, wring and scrub. Sing: This is the way we The: to make it nice and clean

What sounds do these cleaning items make?

What effects can you create using these items?

Choose which item you want to play with/explore.
