13th July – 17th July 2020



This week we are going to be looking forward to enjoying our 6 weeks holiday and completing activities based on **Summer**.

Here's some activities for you to do this week:

Monday:

Choose one of these pictures and I want you to write piece of descriptive writing to go with it. Remember to include lots of adjectives (describing words), similes if you can and remember to show me what is happening, not tell me, this will improve your writing.



Tuesday:

Have a go at solving some of these summer maths problems.

1. I collect some shells on the beach.
I multiply the number of shelves by 5. I then subtract 15, multiply by 7 then divide by 2.
I end up with the number 735.
How many shelves did I collect?
2. I decorate my sandcastles with flags.
I multiply the number of flags by 7. I then add 78, multiply by 4, and divide by 3.
I end up with the number 300.
How many flags did I use to decorate my sandcastle?
3. I practise cartwheels on the sand.
I multiple the number of cartwheels by 8. I then subtract 132, multiply by 10, and divide by 4.
I end up with the number 30.
How many cartwheels did I do?

Can you write a similar problem, once you have written it, email me your problem and I will see if I can solve it.



Wednesday:

Research a holiday destination of your choice. Think about, climate, things to do, how long it would take to get there, where you can stay etc.

Present your information in the style of a holiday brochure or a leaflet or a poster about that destination. Remember it needs to be ABC.

Thursday:

I know we probably can't go too far on holiday this year, but we can always dream.

Design a family friendly hotel for if you could go on holiday. Think about what it would look like and what things you would like to have there that would keep your whole family entertained. It can be as wild and whacky as you like.

Draw your design, colour and label. You could do a birds eye view, a front on view or both.

Friday:

As this is the last week in school, I thought it would be nice for you to write a review about how you have enjoyed your year (even though it hasn't really been "normal").

Start with who you are, your year, your class and maybe a little bit about your friends.

Talk about what you have enjoyed doing in class and if you have any memories of your favourite things you have done, it could be trips we have been on, the topics we have studied or things we have done in class.

You obviously can't leave out lockdown. This is something that probably not many children will experience in their lifetime, so your memories of what you did with your family and how you spent your time will be nice to keep and look back on in the future.

You could finish on what you are looking forward to next year.

Other ideas:

I have put some fun activities on Google Classroom for you to have a go at, you could maybe use these in the Summer too.
