Monday:

Most people enjoy going on a holiday, whether it be a summer holiday abroad, a camping/caravan holiday in Wales, or a winter holiday skiing or a city break. Choose a holiday destination. It could be somewhere you have been, or somewhere that maybe you would like to go. Create a persuasive advert. You could do this orally, using technology (phone or iPad), make a poster or PowerPoint presentation. You will need to research the destination first to put lots of facts into your advert.

Design a holiday souvenir for your chosen holiday destination.

Tuesday:

There are lots of things to do when we go on holiday – go to the beach, have a swim, visit places of interest. Make a comparison of things to do on holiday in a hot country and a cold country. Do this by making a comparison alley, so you can add some pictures to go with your ideas.

Time differences - As it is night in some parts of the world while it is day in other parts, different places in the world have different times. The world is divided into 24 different time zones.


