September Updates

We hope you find the following details useful:

- We ask that all children wear school uniform please.
- Parents are not currently permitted to enter the school building or the yard unless invited to do so.
- Foundation Phase: We will supply pencils, crayons, rubbers etc.
- Juniors: Your child can bring a pencil case/pencils etc. to school and we ask that these remain in school, as we do not want items going back and forth. Please do not rush out to buy items as we have supplies for the children in school.
- Lockers will be available (Foundation Phase & Juniors).
- The children are welcome to have a packed lunch from home or a school dinner can be ordered (usual rates apply).
- As parents have received funds directly into their bank for those children entitled to free school meals, all school meals ordered will need to be paid for (for the first two weeks we believe).
- From Monday 14th September, we will provide a snack for the children (as usual). Please will you continue to contribute towards the snack - we ask for £1 per child per week please. In our first two weeks leading up to 14th September, please will you supply a snack and drink for your child/ren. We have to adhere to healthy eating guidelines and therefore request water/fruit only please.
- Please can everyone follow the times for drop off and collection and we ask for parents to remain at a 2-metre distance from each other and staff at all times.
- Please will everyone try to arrive on time, as late arrivals are difficult for us to accommodate.
- Forest School will commence on Monday 14th September for Years 1 to 6. Please can all children have a forest school kit and working gloves (available at Home Bargains) to be kept in school.
- THE CEFN-Y-BEDD BUS WILL BE OPERATING AS USUAL FROM THURSDAY 3rd SEPTEMBER.
- Primary aged children are not required to wear facemasks in school however if your child wishes to wear one (Juniors) they can do so. Once a child turns eleven, they are asked to wear a facemask on public transport and in communal areas/corridors in school.

Under no circumstances should learners or staff attend school if they:

- **Feel unwell, have any of the four identified COVID-19 symptoms (a new continuous cough, a high temperature or loss of taste or smell) or they have tested positive to COVID-19 in the past 10 days.**
- **Live in a household with someone who has symptoms of COVID-19 or has tested positive to COVID-19 in the past 14 days.**
