


Literacy Tasks – Year 3 & 4

Choose any of the tasks below to keep yourself busy ...



Draw a picture of an alien and write some sentences to describe it, with some WOW words.


Create a WANTED poster for an astronaut. Include a picture and information for what they would need to do or be like.

Imagine you have taken a trip to space. Write a recount of what it would be like. Think about preparing, taking off in a rocket, landing, exploring then returning safely back to Earth.

Write a poem about space. Start each line with "Space is..." Try and use lots of imagery.

Do some research about one of the planets in our solar system. Create a factfile with different headings, information and pictures.

How many different words can you think of that rhyme with space? You could draw a picture to go with them.




Write an adjective (describing word) for every letter of the alphabet.
A - Awesome
B - Brave

Think of some other words that could follow this pattern:
Tall
Taller
Tallest.

Draw a setting of what you think another planet would look like. Then use some WOW words to describe what it would be like on the planet.

Imagine you work for NASA. Write a letter to another child, to introduce yourself, to tell them what NASA does and why it is important.



Think of some red words from RWI. Can you practise spelling them and write them out in your best handwriting?

Read a story to someone in your family. Remember to sound out carefully. Retell the story to the adult at the end, to show you understand what you have read.

After you have read a story, write a book review about the book. Think about the characters, what happened and whether you liked the story.
