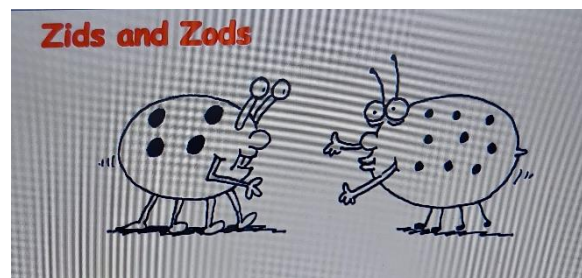
English:

Write a description of what the alien saw, heard and felt as he jumped from the aeroplane down to Earth. Try to use as much descriptive language as you can. Remember to use different sentence starters, short and extended sentences and ambitious vocabulary (wow words). You could also consider using similes and/or metaphors.

Maths:

Zids have 4 spots. Zods have 9 spots.
Altogether some Zids and Zods have 48 spots.
How many Zids are there?
How many Zods are there?

What if Zids have 5 spots, Zods have 7 spots,
and there are 140 spots altogether?
Show your workings out.

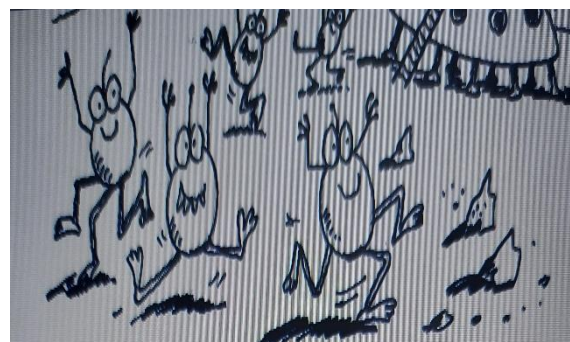


Some Tripods and Bipods flew from planet Zero, There were at least two of each of them.

How many Bipods?

Find two different answers. Show your workings out.



Topic:

Thinking skills time: Think of at least 10 questions about aliens that you would like to have the answers to. Write them down. Make sure you have capital letters at the beginning of your questions and question marks at the end. Here are some of mine:

How fast can aliens run?

Where do aliens like to sleep?

How small is the smallest alien species?
