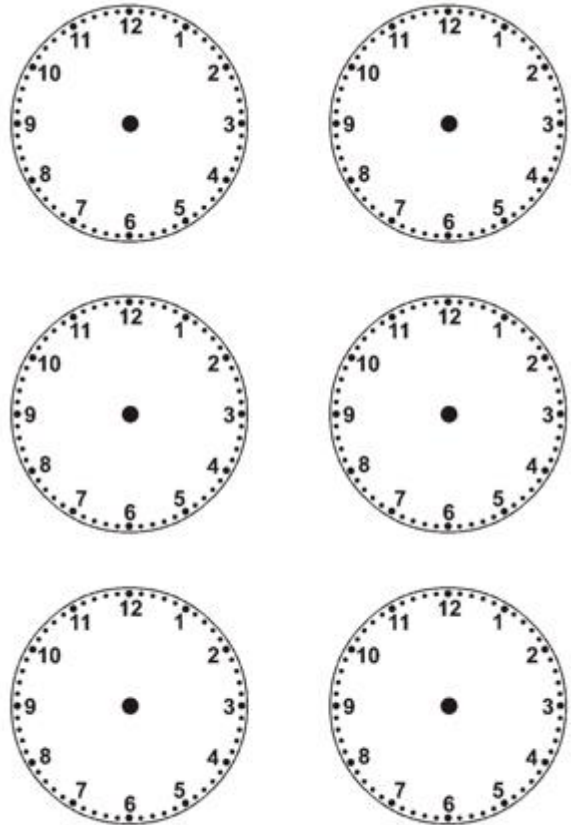




## Home Learning – Tuesday 12th January

Squirrel

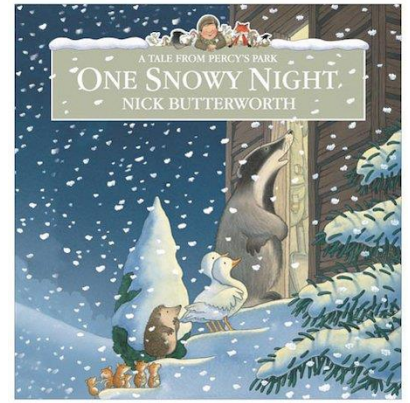
