Once you have listened to the story, I would like you to think of when Stickman felt...



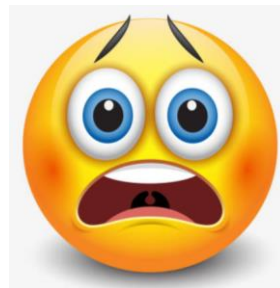
