The layers are:

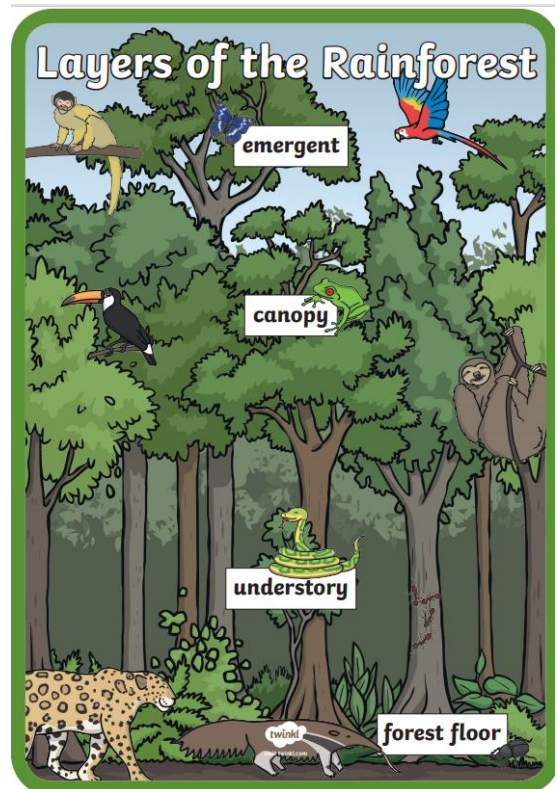
- Emergent
