Warm up

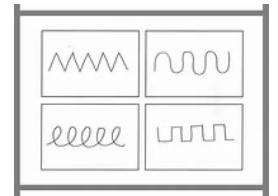
Disco dough

Let's warm up our hands and fingers this morning. You can use play dough or make some with flour and water.

Mark Making

Head outside and look at the marks your feet are making. Can you make a snow angel? Bring some snow in on a tray/plate and poke holes in it. If you want to stay inside get some flour, sugar, shaving foam, shower gel etc. and make marks in that. Can you go round and round, up and down, side to side etc.



Melting

Can you make a dark dark den somewhere? Take in your light toys and torches/phones and see the lights. Have a look at some shiny foil with the torch, put the torch inside a colander/grater and look at the patterns the light makes, can you make shadows with your toys and hands?
